Directions: From SF Bay Area and Central Valley: Take Highway 88 east to Minden Nevada.

From Sacramento: Take Highway 50 to Highway 89 (at bottom of descent off Echo Summit). Right on Highway 89 to Highway 88. Left on Highway 88 to Highway 395 in Minden Nevada.

From Reno: Take 395 south to Minden.

MapQuest address: 1607-1614 Mono Ave Minden, Nevada.

Registration: Opens at 7:00 at Gazebo in the center of Minden Park. Closes 15 min before each start time.

Course: A great 0.8 mile downtown course around beautiful Minden Park. Four 90 degree right turns followed by a right/left chicane on to the finishing straight. Excellent pavement. **There is a church located on the course, during the following hours no bikes will be allowed near the church. 8:50am-9:00am, 9:50am-10:00am and 11:40am-12:00pm.**

Restrooms: Available in Minden Park *ANYONE caught relieving themselves in public will be subject to immediate disqualification and possible arrest. Additionally, we will take all possible measures to have your racing license revoked.*
